Skin Color Types

Human skin colors are divided into six types. Check the skin color type that matches your skin (tinted = colored).

- **O** 1 Very light skin, often with freckles and red or light blonde hair
- **O 2** Light skin, often with blonde hair and gray, green, or blue eyes
- **O 3** Lightly tinted skin, often with dark blonde to brown hair and fairly dark eyes
- **O 4** Tinted skin, often with dark hair and dark eyes
- **O 5** Dark skin, often with dark to black hair and dark eyes
- **O 6** Very dark skin, often with black hair and dark eyes
